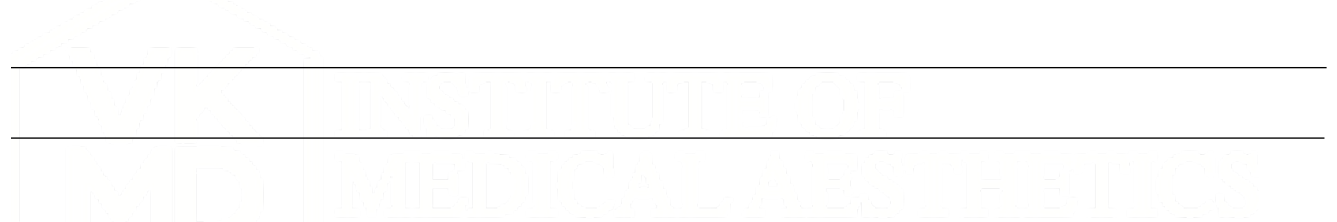

METHOD AND TERMS OF PAYMENT:

It is recommended that the student research their banking institution or local banks and credit unions for private school loans, prior to committing to an in-house monthly installment plan, as the terms of those loans are often with less paid interest to the student and therefore more cost-efficient.

In-house financing is available *only if the student is unable to obtain personal private student financing from an outside lender or pay in full*. In this instance, the student is allowed to pay their tuition in monthly installments and must be paid in full prior to the start of baby boards classes (aka state boards preparation, which we provide at no additional cost within our program). **Tuition must be paid in full and with on-time payments made according to Enrollment Agreement prior to baby boards prep, typically 3 or 4 weeks prior to graduation.**

The methods of payment of monies owed to VKMD Institute of Medical Aesthetics may be paid with the following options: Cash, Cashier's Check, Personal Checks, Credit Card (***there will be an additional 3% processing fee for all credit/debit card transactions, so it is therefore recommended to pay with cashier's/personal check or cash***). All installment payments will be tracked through our online platform and are available to the student at any time. **All credit card processing fees are non-refundable**

In-house payment plans will be followed according to the rules of this enrollment agreement only if declined by a third-party financier. Proof of decline is required before our in-house monthly installment plan is set up. Payment plans may be divided into 2, 3, 4, or 5 consecutive installments (after the \$2999.00 down payment has been made), with the first payment due on the commencement of the first day of class, and then on the following 1st day of each consecutive month until paid in full. With each payment installment, a \$75.00 additional fee will apply and will be added to your payment amount, after an initial \$250 set up fee is applied to your first payment.

All installment fees and Credit Card fees are non-refundable

Gifts with 600 Hours General Esthetics: The Foundation Course Purchase and Alumni Perks

Our 600 Hours General Esthetics: The Foundation course includes the prestigious NCEA-Certification credential, CPR/First Aid certification, ASCP student membership during your time at our school, and Face Reality Acne Expert training. Students must complete these programs within the duration of the 600 hours prior to graduation, as they are a significant portion of our curriculum.

Upon completion of the 600 Hours General Esthetics: The Foundation at VKMD Institute of Medical Aesthetics, and once state boards have been successfully passed, our students are then eligible to receive their gift from us, which are the **Core 4: The Essentials** - Microdermabrasion, Dermaplane, Chemical Peels, and Microneedling. These stand-alone advanced courses are **free** to our post-graduate, licensed students as a gesture of gratitude for choosing to complete their *600 Hours General Esthetics: The Foundation at VKMD Institute of Medical Aesthetics*. Therefore, these courses are not eligible for a refund should our alumni choose not to take advantage of their gift, as they are not required to do so. Students will have **6 months** to take advantage of taking these 4 free courses upon graduation from our program, after which the gift will expire. Students will be disqualified for eligibility of this gift if they receive any disciplinary action during their tenure at our school. Though not necessary, kits for these programs are available for additional purchase and affordable cost

REFUND POLICY

1. An applicant not accepted for training by the school shall be entitled to a refund of all monies paid.
2. If a student pays in full then cancels his/her enrollment and requests his/her money back in writing within three (3) days are entitled to a full refund of all tuition and fees paid. Students who withdraw after three (3) days, but before commencement of classes, are entitled to a full refund of all tuition and fees paid except for the maximum cancellation penalty/charge of \$150.00 or 25% of the contract price, whichever is less, and excluding the non-refundable portion of the down payment made upon enrollment (\$2849.00), unless the student has begun training within that 3 day period. If the student has begun training within the 3-day period, the table below will apply accordingly. Students who withdraw from the **600-Hour General Esthetics: The Foundation** program at any time are subject to our \$150.00 cancellation fee.
3. If either party postpones the start date, the contract will be extended to the new scheduled date of completion.
4. For students who enroll in, and begin classes, the following schedule of tuition adjustments is authorized, exclusive of books, tools, supplies, All learning materials, and kits, or the non-refundable \$2849 portion of the original down payment made upon enrollment, any additional fees incurred such as payment installment fees, credit card payment fees, or any additional retail or product purchases made to the school outside of tuition.

5. Enrollment time is defined as the time elapsed between the actual starting date and the date of the student's last day of physical attendance in school. Refunds must be calculated based on the clock hours completed as of the last day of recorded attendance. Any monies due to the student shall be refunded within thirty (30) days after cancellation or termination, or in the case of a leave of absence, the documented date of return.

6. **The student might be granted credit for previous training hours that are approved by the State of Colorado on an individual basis. The time lapse between transfer is not to exceed 3 months. The full cost of our program will still apply regardless of the number of credit hours transferred. The policy for the granting of credit for previous training shall not impact the refund policy.**

7. When situations of mitigating circumstances are in evidence, the school may provide a refund, which exceeds this refund policy. This will be to the discretion of the school, and is not guaranteed.

8. The cost of the kit, supplies, and all educational materials are part of the \$2,999.00 down payment for *600 Hours General Esthetics: The Foundation* tuition fees.

9. For all advanced/stand-alone courses, the non-refundable \$150 fee will apply towards the overall tuition for the applicable course. For Permanent Makeup and Laser Device Courses, the non-refundable "save your spot fee" is \$1500 and will apply to your overall cost of advanced courses applicable program.

10. The school applies the refund policy to all terminations for any reason, by either party, including student decision, course/or program cancellation, or institution closure. Students who terminate prior or during the course completion will not be refunded the \$150 or \$1500 "save your spot" fee for the 600-hour General Esthetics: The Foundation course or stand-alone advanced courses.

11. If the school is permanently closed and no longer offers instruction after a student has enrolled, the student shall be entitled to a pro-rata refund of tuition. VKMD maintains a Surety bond (insurance policy) for each enrolled student, which covers student tuition in such cases.

12. If a course is discontinued after the student has enrolled, the student shall be entitled to a full refund, EXCEPT if the school ceases operation. The school reserves the right to reschedule, postpone, or cancel classes.

13. For duplication of previously transferred transcript paperwork, a fee of \$25.00 will be charged and paid each time prior to duplication of transcripts. The school does not guarantee the transferability of its credits to any other institution unless there is a written agreement with another institution. All requests for duplicate transcripts must be in writing.

14. In case of illness or disabling accident, death in the immediate family, or other circumstances beyond the control of the student, the school will make a settlement which is reasonable and fair to both parties based on the refund table.

There is a 2-year limitation (from the student's last date of attendance) on a student filing complaint. We encourage resolving the issue directly with the school first.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

I understand that in order to graduate from the **600 Hour General Esthetics: The Foundation** program and to receive my respective diploma, I must successfully complete the required number of clock hours as specified in the course catalog as well as this enrollment agreement contract, pass all written and practical examinations with an 80% (B average or better), 85% attendance, and satisfy all financial obligations to the school.

GROUNDS FOR TERMINATION

I agree to comply with the rules and policies of the school, and I understand that the school shall have the right to terminate this contract along with my enrollment at any time, for violation of the rules and policies as outlined in the Catalog.
